

THE BARBADOS CITIZENSHIP ACT, CAP. 186

The Barbados Citizenship Regulations, 1967

(Regulation 6)

APPLICATION by an Alien or British Protected Person for a Certificate of Naturalisation

CAUTION - Section 15(1) of the Barbados Citizenship Act, Cap. 186, provides that:-

"Any person who for the purpose of procuring anything to be done or not to be done under this Act or under the provisions of Chapter II of the Constitution, makes any statement which he knows to be false in a material particular, or recklessly makes a statement which is false in a material particular, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction thereof by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine not exceeding 500 dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment."

The form must be read carefully before it is completed. Portions of the form which are not applicable should be struck out and initialled in every case.
